Yet, sometimes being a leaders is a very difficult, stressful and thankless job. Well, in November we received a great blessing as we were privileged to go together as a couple to Indaba, a conference for AIM leaders across Southern Africa. We were greatly encouraged by the fellowship, worship and teaching we received. Alisa then went on to represent Namibia at the AIM International Short Term mission forum in Madagascar. This provided further enrichment for her and equipped us further for leadership. This was only possible because Mom and Dad Greidanus sacrificed themselves to make the long journey over and look after our kids while we were away. What a blessing that was! It also provided great opportunity for them to bond with the kids and work through a few conflicts :). We know that many of you have been praying for Paloma's adoption and are wondering how things are going with her. We are happy to report that over the last month we have seen some significant developments.
